Sermon: The Family of God

Date: 10-15-17

- What does it mean, practically, that Jesus is the center of Christian fellowship? What are some of the ways that we forget this? (In other words, what happens when we try to have “fellowship” that is not rooted in His presence in our midst?)
- We talked about the difference ways of seeing the tiger picture. Your group may even have some who are still unable to see the picture any other way. What does this say about our struggle to live in community? What are some ways we can grow in terms of not being so individualistic?
- What are some ways you have settled for “geographical closeness or proximity” but have not gone all the way with “nearness by approach” spiritually?
- What might be some steps you need to take—that might even seem counterintuitive at first—to leave a spot you’ve settled on that is still far from where God is calling you?
- Do you often think of welcoming others into fellowship as contributing to *your* joy? If not, why not? If so, what are some things that helped take you to that point?
- What is at least 1 practical thing you can do to make room for someone else to be a part of your church or group?
- Spend some time giving thanks and praise to the One who went out of His way to bring you into fellowship with God.
