Sermon: The Gospel in Seed Form

Date: 2-4-18

- We heard how the farmer was particularly extravagant with his seed. In what ways have you personally benefited from God's lavishness? Can you think of ways you tend to be stingy with what you give to others?
- The first type of soil was hard. Have you ever resisted something God was trying to teach you? What were those circumstances?
- The second soil was shallow. Sometimes those quickest to respond spiritually are also the quickest to leave. Have you ever fizzled on something God was doing because it became difficult?
- The third soil was overcrowded. What are some "thorns" in your life? Try to stick with the parable's meaning. Think of thorns as other plants, not necessarily as nuisances.
- The fourth soil was the good soil. What characterizes good soil spiritually? Have you seen evidence of this in your own life? What are some examples you admire in other people?
- How do you normally tend to think of people who are "bad soil"? How does seeing Jesus as the Seed change that?
- Pray that God would use your group to produce a crop in one another's lives.
