Sermon: Healer, Savior, Lord

- Jesus calmed the sea, drove out a legion of demons, healed a woman, and raised a dead girl. Imagine having a front row seat to each of those miracles. Which ones would seem most remarkable to you? Why?
- The various situations in these chapters are all picture lessons of the brokenness of the human condition. In what ways do you see that brokenness in the world around you? In your own heart?
- "Palliative care" is essentially symptom management without treating the underlying cause. (It has its time and place medically.) In what ways are Christians guilty of this spiritually? What negative things happen as a result?
- "Jesus is Lord of all, or He's not Lord at all." We often come to Jesus for relief without wanting to submit to His authority. How have you seen this in your own life?
- What is a situation right now where you are tempted to fear? How can you cultivate a healthy fear of the Lord instead?
- Pray for one another as a group. Ask God to make you each whole in the various ways that are needed. Ask Him to make you agents of His restoration to others.
