Sermon: The Transfiguration

Date: 3-18-18

- Though Jesus was incarnated as a man, at the Transfiguration the veil over His true glory was temporarily lifted. As a conversation starter, has there ever been a time when you interacted with someone as a commoner, only later to find out that they had far more power and influence than you at first thought? (TV shows like “Undercover Boss” regular try to capitalize on this “glorious among you” idea.)
- Paul speaks of believers being changed from one degree of glory to another. What examples of such change have you experienced in your own life?
- Perhaps try the “fruit of the Spirit” exercise as a group. Read through the fruit of the Spirit in Galatians 5. Which one are you most lacking in? Share that with your group and pray for transformation in each person’s area.
- Every single person is made in the image of God. How much more for believers, who bear the image of Christ! How would your life be different if you were to realize that each person you interact with is a vessel of more glory than you could possibly imagine?
- Last week we heard about partial vision vs. full vision. Together, the various parts of “the Hinge of Mark” show that to know Christ is to share in His sufferings so that we might also share in the glory of His resurrection. Pray that this twofold reality would be true in one another’s life.
