Sermon: The King of Glory

Date: 1-13-19

- "The earth is the Lord's." How has this served as a motivation to prayer for you in the past?
- What doubts come to mind when you think about "the earth is the Lord's, and everything in it"?
- The Psalm doesn't just talk about trusting that God is able to give us things. It speaks of a direct communion with God ("who seek your face"). How does this inspire you to think about prayer?
- Verses 3 and 4 spell out "qualifications" of someone who receives the blessing of God's presence. How have you struggled to grow in these qualities in your own life?
- What (or Who) is the ultimate solution to this struggle to approach God?
- Spend some time praying that Jesus, the King of Glory, may come in to each situation your group members are facing.
