Job Description

Position: Technical Director

Staff Level: Reporting to Administrative Pastor and Church Board

Employment Status: Part-time position, but may become full-time

Position Overview: The Technical Director is primarily responsible for providing leadership and management to all technical operations that involve the development and support of worship technologies at Antrim BIC Church. They are responsible for anticipating future needs and being able to present a plan and budget for future use of emerging technology. The director will be responsible for all activities that require worship techs. This position requires a firm grasp of the beliefs and values of Antrim BIC Church.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- The Technical Director will understand the use of creative elements in various styles of worship. They will be responsible for the following:
 - Working closely with the Office to update projection computers with slides, video, and sermons
 - Work closely with the Worship Leaders and Pastors to ensure worship direction for all services and events
 - Directly responsible for the production aspects of all Sunday Services and special events that includes lighting, projections, live streaming, and sound
- Lead, Train, and develop volunteer teams in executing live audio/visual for weekend services and special events, including live streaming, projection, recording, and sound
- Maintain all Audio Visual equipment; assist in purchasing and upgrading equipment when needed

Qualifications:

- Shall profess a saving relationship with Jesus Christ. Must be born-again for at least five years and shall demonstrate growth in their spiritual walk
- Must possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Must have a Bachelors degree in audio technology or related field or a minimum of 3 years of experience in technical ministries
- Knowledge and experience with recent/up-to-date audio equipment and technologies
- Proven leadership, interpersonal, and administrative skills/experience
- Must be able to work in a rapidly changing environment with multiple priorities
- Knowledge of post-production audio
- Broad operational understanding/knowledge of full scope of technical ministries
- Experience and basic understanding of automated and conventional lighting
- Proficient on Widows platform
- Understanding of video projection systems
- Must be able to lift up to 50lbs alone
