- How is the thought that "searching for pornography reveals dimensions of one's life that await love" different from how you've thought about sexual sin in the past? Does this help you have insight, compassion, and understanding for those who struggle with sexual immorality?
- While every accountability and prevention measure has its place, how is the approach of today's passage different from merely trying to use a lot of safety protocols to prevent using pornography? Which do you think is more likely to be effective in the long run? How so?
- Whether it's sexual sin or another area, how do you see the need for love influencing your life? What would connecting Jesus' passive *and* active righteousness to that need look like very practically for you?
